- 5) For the purpose of receiving the Litigation Report from the General Counsel relating to pending or imminent litigation, specific claims or grievances; and to receive legal advice on specific legal questions, including legal questions regarding the meeting topics referenced above, which is confidential pursuant to C.R.S. § 24-6-402 (3) (a) (II).
